



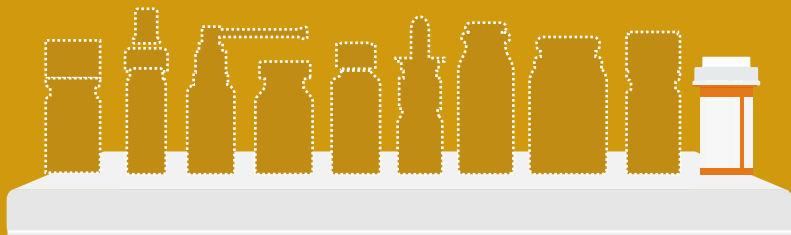
What is going wrong with mandatory stockpiling in the EU?

Without coordination, mandatory stockpiling is not a solution, **it's a risk for patients.**





9 out of 10
generic medicine suppliers
identify **increased costs and operational complexity** as one of the **most critical risks**
to long-term supply availability.





7 out of 10 companies
have had to destroy stockpiled medicines
due to overstocking or strict expiry rules.





9 out of 10 companies

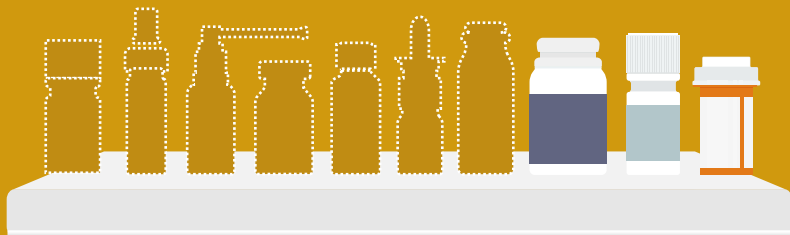
have observed **longer stockouts periods and reduced availability in smaller markets** as stock is diverted to meet larger-country obligations.





7 out of 10 companies

have observed **oversupply in some countries**
and shortages in others due to
uncoordinated stockpiling.





5 out of 10 of companies

had to **discontinue products**, reducing patient access, **in the name of regulatory compliance**, especially in hospital tenders.
